Our Water is Okay!

Our association has lately been riding quite a roller coaster regarding the quality of our water.

We are happy to report that the most recent battery of tests conducted on our water at six different locations in the neighborhood has shown arsenic levels BELOW the international limits for arsenic.

Arsenic levels in the water at Lakeside vary significantly. The variations can be caused by seasonal rain levels or differing chemical concentrations in the surrounding rock strata.

We are happy to report that our association water continues to be clean and potable.

Water Conservation

Water continues to be an important topic in Lakeside neighborhoods.

Our population at Lakeside as well as in Guadalajara is growing. This growth is causing increasing usage of water.

Now and in the future all of us must take steps to use water wisely. One important place to reduce water consumption is in the garden.

Some ways to conserve water include:

- Applying mulch to reduce evaporation and supply nutrients
- Using automatic watering systems
- Reducing the amount of grass or lawn.
- Planting low water-use plants such as:
- Succulents, cacti
- Oleander
- Lantana
- Bougainvillea

Conserve water now, so we will have enough water in the future.

Recently our neighbors have experienced some robberies and a very unfortunate assault. We urge all residents to be very careful about their home security. Here are some recommended precautions.

- Lock all entrance doors, windows and gates.
