Hot Weather gardening tips

Our wonderful summer weather is fast approaching or for some, has already arrived. The sun is hot and shining but the shade is cool and inviting. As you sip a cool drink, check out these hot weather hints.

Plants need some extra care during this time to be healthy and happy. Some hot weather gardening tips are:

- Mulch heavily around plants - use grass clippings, compost, shredded newspaper
- Water purposely - water in the early morning or late evening, use drip irrigation or soaker hoses if possible, water deeply every few days
- Trim foliage that is old and dry
- Move stressed container plants to the shade

It's important to avoid standing water, especially during the hot season. Mosquitoes love standing water, but we don't want to provide a home for any of our dengue-carrying insect friends. Be sure to clean out buckets, birdbaths, or construction debris where water could accumulate. Add a little bleach to the saucers under plant pots.

Don't forget your pets. Provide plenty of cool drinking water and a shady place to sleep.
